Helpful Notes:

- 1) Login Cards Print Lexia login cards from Lexia! Click Manage, then select the class, and Print Login Cards.
- 2) Print Rosters Print Lexia login rosters from Lexia! Click Manage, then select the class, and Print Rosters.
- 3) **Resource Tab** If you are looking for a quick specific skill lesson, check out the Lexia Resource tab! You can search for specific grade level skills.
 - a. Lexia Lessons These are direct instruction lessons that would be great for reteaching a specific skill that a student did not master in Lexia or in the classroom.
 - b. Lexia Skill Builders These are intended to reinforce the skills students learned after completing a lesson online. They can be completed independently or with a teacher. These would be great to differentiate for students as they master lessons online, they could use these for centers in classrooms to reinforce and continue practice with what they have learned.
 - c. Lexia Instructional Connections These include ideas for teachers to use in the classroom to teach and connect specific skills.

Lexia Lessons and Reports:

- 1) On the reading tab, the "dashboard" provides a lot of information, including
 - a. Usage As with any program, consistent use is key. Monitor students' use of the program, and if they are meeting the "prescribed" amount.
 - b. Progress As students progress in lessons, they can be recognized on the news show for Leveling Up!
 - c. Skills Report
 - d. Lexia Lessons

Creating Groups:

You may want to create group of your RtI students or another group to better track their progress on Lexia.

- 1) Click Manage.
- 2) Click the + symbol at the bottom of the screen.
- 3) Type in Group Name.
- 4) Select Grade.
- 5) Click Add Students.
- 6) Select the students that you want in your group.
- 7) Click Add to Selected Students, then Done.
- 8) Click Save.
